What a story they'll have to tell. For over a week the two wives have enjoyed the big city from theatres, United Nations, Ferry boat rides, bank runs, TV shows etc., & then THI S. 8 states and the entire city of N.Y. were blacked out completely.

Nov. 18. Still still in N.Y. Flew in Co plane to Pgh. & was there for the day. Carol went to Paris Nov. 1st & saw Phillippe. She loves the family with whom she lives. It's being harder than y that to give up my car but I must. I have developed chest pains that cause me feel dizzy at times.

Nov. 22 Two years ago today our beloved Pres. Kennedy was killed. The world still grieves his passing. World in Vietnam is cruel and spreading.

Dec 25-65 Xmas day. Stell phoned that Chas. arrived from N.Y. on the 21st, they have given up the apt. at 3417 Montrose, stored their furniture and are on their way to California to see Mike! after California what? We are having Terri & Natalia for a turkey dinner. Weather is beautiful. Hope Pawle is enjoying her skiing.

Feb 4 The Russian Space craft "Lunar 9" did make a soft landing on the moon. England intercepted the first pictures. President is leaving for Hawaii. The Viet-Nam war is a hard nut to crack & looks as though I'm going abroad. Still will go too.

Feb 15-17 Went to S.A. To see the Rod & Co.

" 18 - Saw "Noche Mexicana" matinee at

3 P.M. in the new Civic Center -

Feb 23 It has been bitter cold.

At the 3rd try today the mightiest rocket

April 2 Carole's 20th. Birthday. Best to her! A 3 day R.R. strike which hit hard all over the country will be over tomorrow. The Russians have done it - orbited in a moon satellite.

April. 30 Mary + Ralph were here. Went across + ate at "El Rio". Still phoned that Chas. can't leave N.Y. yet so our visit here is off.

May 2 - Broke my right-front tooth?

May 8. Mother's Day. Still called from N.Y. and we talked about an hour. We are all excited about our trip. Carole is full of plans. She won't be home until August - I am still toothless! We are still fighting in Vietnam. There's much opposition among legislators. Feel for our President.

May 16 - Mrs. W.A. Wright was named "Woman of the Year".

" 18 - Gemini 9 goes up today. Astronauts Stafford + Eugene Cernan will take the complicated journey.

Bad luck Gemini 9 failed to orbit.

May 26 A new nation is born. British Guiana lowered the Union Jack + up went a 5 colored flag of Guyana. Am all excited about my trips. Elias' house is almost finished with repairs. Kitchen cabinets finally arrived as did the newly upholstered couch. Now for the carpet! Stella calls nearly every Saturday. Pancho graduated from Hi School last night. Mike seems to be doing well with his "Skateboard". Many can't see it.

June 1. Gemini 9 goes up today. Astronauts Stafford + Cernan are inside the craft. Am all ready for my trips. Something went wrong 3 min before take-off + launching is postponed until perhaps Friday. Elias' house begins to look beautiful with clean walls + carpeting!

June 3 - Surveyor Space Craft made a perfect soft landing on the moon at about 1 AM this day. Scientists are jubilant. Pictures sent back are clear + revealing.

July 1st 1966 Just back from my trip to Europe. What a thrilling experience! Met Still in N.Y. boarded Transworld at Kennedy + landed in Paris where Carole was waiting. To see Paris, Barcelona + Madrid in 3 weeks + in company of the daughter + grand was sheer delight. N.Y. is great too. Saw a beautiful performance at Rockefeller Center Music Hall.

July 12 Elisa's house is looking fine after re-finishing + having new furniture. Air Lines are on strike - great loss of business + much canceling of vacation trips. We are losing the Yeldings. They go to Arkansas.

Aug 17 Have neglected this Diary. One blessing - this air-line strike is over - planes will fly again by Saturday. Another good news - Carole is supposed to arrive in N.Y. tomorrow + Katherine with her. Dolores McClure is visiting Cubs now.
